Dear Mamdouh, Dear Ahmad

referring to todays info of somebody filling (packing) cement currently in our plant,

I think and assume:

- there is no electricity (and no compressed air) in the plant
- packing machines and packing plant is not used at all
- the cement which is "filled" is collected from silo openings (which you can open manually) like gates, poke holes, ...
- collection of cement is only mechanical (like when we have lumps in silo / in front of the gate and you poke & clean)
- the collected cement is filled into open barrels / buckets, open plastic bags, open paper bags, ....
- in case our Lafarge bags are used, first they need to cut & slit the bags on the top side in order to fill the cement by shovel or bucket
- transportation of open bags only in standing position on small trucks, pick-ups, minivans or in the trunk
- the daily quantity filled, can not be very much, maybe 5000 to 10.000 kg (?)

Please can somebody check and verify this assumptions.
