As per our discussion regarding the new event at the plant (stealing the cement from our silos and selling cement in areas near the plant which we don't know exactly where)

As a suggestion, I see that LCS is responsible to inform the government about its situation and explain the event from the beginning that occurred on 19th September where ISIS took over LCS plant, the evacuation that happened, and that we have suspended production and closed the plant since that date, and that now they are selling our cement as we heard.

I see this suggestion is logical especially that LCS head offices are located in Damascus (Government controlled area) therefore it is better that this news is heard from our side than to be acknowledged by them alone.
